The Gloria is a hymn, not an acclamation.

To welcome the stranger is to welcome Christ. If you are comfortable, please greet those neighbors and fellow parishioners around you, especially someone you have not yet met.

While the priest is receiving the Sacrament, the Communion hymn is begun. Its purpose is to express our union in spirit by the union of our voices, showing the “communitarian” nature of the procession to receive Communion. We sing as long as the Sacrament is being received.
